COLD OPEN

INT. CAVERN

SCROOGE, HUEY, DEWEY, and LOUIE search the floor of a large cavern as they wear bulky goggles.

The cavern is lit by a giant green crystal on the ceiling and the faint glow of green ore in the walls.

The floor is littered with various skeletons, rocks, and giant fangs.

Louie fidgets with his goggles.

LOUIE

(whispers)

Ugh. This is so annoying.

DEWEY

(whispers)

Do we really need these goggles Uncle Scrooge?

SCROOGE

(whispers)

Aye lads. Nobody wants to get an eye full of...

Scrooge gestures behind him to a giant demonic serpent, the BASILISK, fast asleep.

SCROOGE (CONT'D)

(whispers)

The basilisk!

DEWEY

(whispers)

Or do they?

Dewey walks off towards the basilisk.

Huey pulls out the Junior Woodchuck Guidebook and pages through it.

HUEY

(whispers)

It says here that even one direct look will leave you dead as a doorknob.

Huey picks up a skull shaped like a doorknob.

HUEY (CONT'D)

(whispers)

Peculiar...

LOUIE

(whispers)

Then lets just grab a fang and go already.

Louie walks up to a fang and grabs it. He struggles to pull it out of the ground.

SCROOGE

(whispers)

Its got to be fresh. It's not the fang we need, but the venom. It's like liquid gold.

Louie stops trying to lift the fang and continues his search.

He stumbles under the weight of his goggles--

--trips over a bone--

-- and falls face first.

Louie looks up to see a bear head staring at him.

LOUIE

Wha-? Wahhh!?!?

Louie picks himself up and finds a shiny fang coated in purple venom protruding from the bear carcass.

LOUIE (CONT'D)

Hey I found it!

Scrooge and Huey run over to Louie flailing their arms.

SCROOGE/HUEY

(whispers)

Shhhhhh!

Louie covers his mouth in a panic.

The three of them look over to a sleeping basilisk as Dewey records it on his cellphone.

SCROOGE/LOUIE/HUEY

(whispers)

Dewey!

DEWEY

(whispers)

What? Do guys realize how many clicks this'll get?

Scrooge grasps the fang.

SCROOGE

(whispers)

Just get over here and give us a hand.

Huey and Louie help Scrooge lift the fang and carry it towards the exit.

DEWEY

(whispers)

Okay, okay. Just one quick selfie.

Dewey poses in front of the basilisk.

His camera flashes as he takes the selfie, waking up the basilisk.

DEWEY (CONT'D)

Oh boy.

END OF COLD OPEN

ACT 1

INT. CAVERN

As the basilisk chases Dewey, it lets out a deafening ROAR which shakes the cavern walls.

DEWEY

Help!!!

Scrooge lets go of the fang. Huey and Louie struggle to lift it.

SCROOGE

Get going with the fang!

Scrooge runs into the cavern, picks up a rock, and hurls it at the basilisk.

SCROOGE (CONT'D)

Over here ya oversized worm!

The basilisk charges at Scrooge who jumps onto its head and rides it like a bull.

SCROOGE (CONT'D)

Dewey run for the exit!

Dewey runs over and helps the others lift the fang.

HUEY

Quick lets go!

LOUIE

Wait. If this venom is like liquid gold, why stop at one?

DEWEY

We don't have time for one of your get rich quick schemes!

LOUIE

You're right. I guess beating a basilisk doesn't do much for social media.

Dewey raises his finger to object, but stops himself.

DEWEY

...Okay what's the plan?

HUEY

Dewey!

Scrooge rams the basilisk into a wall. The impact shakes the entire cavern.

Louie looks up and sees the giant crystal on the ceiling shaking loose.

LOUTE

Follow my lead!

Louie and Dewey run back into the cavern, leaving Huey to collapse under the weight of the fang.

HUEY

Guys wait!

Scrooge hops off the basilisk, which is now disoriented, and runs towards the exit.

SCROOGE

That oughta-

Louie and Dewey run past Scrooge.

SCROOGE (CONT'D)

Blazin bagpipes, what are you doin?!

Louie runs to a far wall.

LOUIE

Hey over here!

The basilisk charges at Louie.

Louie jumps out of the way as the basilisk crashes into the wall, shaking the cavern.

Dewey frantically waves his arms from the across the cavern.

DEWEY

I've eaten gummy worms stronger than you big guy!

The basilisk charges at Dewey.

Dewey jumps out of the way as the basilisk crashes into the wall, shaking the cavern.

Louie and Dewey meet in the center of the cavern. They shake their butts as they taunt the basilisk.

DEWEY (CONT'D)

King of snakes?

LOUIE

More like king of fakes!

The basilisk charges at them.

SCROOGE

Boys no!

Scrooge desperately runs towards the Louie and Dewey.

The basilisk winds up to strike--

-- the giant crystal falls from the ceiling--

--crashes down on the basilisk--

--who falls over, out cold.

DEWEY LOUIE

Booyah!

We're rich!

Louie and Dewey run over to the basilisk as Scrooge stands dumbfounded.

Dewey stands triumphantly over the basilisk for a selfie as Louie works to pry open its mouth.

DEWEY (CONT'D)

This'll be trending in no time!

LOUIE

Huey! Scrooge! Give me a hand?

Scrooge rolls up his sleeves and walks up to Huey and Louie.

He grabs them by the collar and drags them off.

DEWEY LOUIE (CONT'D)

Hey wait! What?!

SMASH CUT TO:

INT. MCDUCK MANSION - FOYER - DAY

Scrooge kicks down the door to the mansion. He drags Louie and Dewey in as Huey struggles to carry the basilisk fang.

Louie and Dewey squirm relentlessly in an attempt to break free.

SCROOGE

I've had it up to here with your reckless abandon!

WEBBY runs in excited, but quickly becomes nervous at the sight of Scrooge dragging the boys.

SCROOGE (CONT'D)

It's time you-!

Scrooge looks to Webby with a smile.

SCROOGE (CONT'D)

(fondly)

Here you are lass.

Scrooge nods back to Huey as he hobbles behind him.

Huey collapses to the ground. The fang smashes into the floor in front of Webby.

SCROOGE (CONT'D)

-learned a lesson!

Louie and Dewey break free from Scrooge's grasp.

Scrooge turns to them as they pat down their dusty wrinkled shirts.

DEWEY

You're overreacting.

LOUIE

We had it handled.

SCROOGE

Ya got lucky is all!

DEWEY

We've defeated a sorcerer's shadow army and stopped an alien invasion.

LOUIE

I think we can handle a big snake.

SCROOGE

You didn't do that.

Scrooge gestures to everyone in the room.

SCROOGE (CONT'D)

We all did it together!

Scrooge lets out a SIGH.

SCROOGE (CONT'D)

Listen lads, I get it. You feel indestructible, like the whole world is yours for the taking. That's youth! I was much the same way at your age, but-

LOUIE

You're saying because we're young we're too eager?!

Webby steps between Scrooge and the boys.

WEBBY

Now guys-

DEWEY

Maybe the real problem is that you've become a miser in your old age.

Webby and Scrooge stand shocked.

Scrooge's face turns red with anger as he grits his teeth.

SCROOGE

Old... you're calling me old?

Huey runs up to Dewey and grabs him by his shirt.

HUEY

(whispers)

Think about what you're saying.

LOUIE

I mean let's be real, you're ancient.

Huey turns to Louie, mouth agape.

Webby nervously backs out of the room. She drags the fang with her which rips up the floor.

SCROOGE

THAT'S IT! You're gonna learn some respect! A real punishment for once!

Scrooge scoops up all the boys.

DEWEY/LOUIE

HUEY

Hey!

Why me?!

INT. MCDUCK MANSION - ARCHIVES - CONTINUOUS

Scrooge kicks open the door to a dimly lit room.

It's filled with shelves lined with books and beakers, treasures in display cases, and various trunks.

He throws the boys into the room.

SCROOGE

Starting with taking inventory of my archives until you learn to grow up a bit!

Scrooge tosses a clipboard at the boys.

SCROOGE (CONT'D)

Then we'll see what I have for you next.

Scrooge leaves and slams the door behind him.

Huey picks up the clipboard.

HUEY

Thanks a lot guys! I didn't even do anything.

LOUIE

Yeah well, you didn't do anything in the cavern either. Consider it even.

HUEY

Unlike you I did exactly what I should've.

Huey pulls out the Junior Woodchuck Guidebook.

HUEY (CONT'D)

Junior Woodchuck rule #96, "Always listen your elders".

Dewey swipes the guidebook from Huey.

DEWEY

Which one of these rules is making you a stick in the mud like Scrooge?

HUEY

Haha. Now cut it out.

DEWEY

I'm serious. I bet you couldn't just go with the flow for even one day.

HUEY

Bet ya I can.

DEWEY

Alright, it's a bet.

Dewey hold out the guidebook like a bible.

DEWEY (CONT'D)

Swear on the guidebook that you will for one day. Winner picks the next adventure.

Huey stares nervously at the guidebook, then steels himself and places his left hand over it.

HUEY

I swear.

DEWEY

Great! First thing, no more quidebook.

Huey looks on shocked as Dewey tosses the guide to Louie.

DEWEY (CONT'D)

And no more Junior Woodchuck rules.

Louie pockets the guide as Huey composes himself.

HUEY

Yeah that's... cool.

DEWEY

That adventure is as good as mine.

LOUIE

If we ever get our own adventure!
Just look at all this dumb stuff.

Louie kicks over a sack, which spills glowing beans.

HUEY

Magic beans, check.

Huey fills out the clipboard, then scoops the beans back into the sack.

Louie walks over and picks up a Siberian crown.

LOUTE

The Lost Crown of Genghis Khan.

Louie throws it over his shoulder. It lands perfectly on Dewey's head.

Dewey poses for a selfie as Huey fills out the clipboard.

HUEY

Check.

The boys approach a sword hilt hung horizontally on the wall.

LOUIE

Excalibur!

The boys follow it down the wall, revealing the sword is still lodged in stone.

DEWEY

And he couldn't even pull the thing!

Huey looks around puzzled, then back to the clipboard.

HUEY

Hmmm looks like we never got the Holy Grail back from the Beagle Boys.

Louie turns to Huey and swipes the clipboard. He flips through the pages.

LOUIE

Don't you see?! Whenever Scrooge wants something we just get it, but the second we want something "it's too dangerous". I'm sick of it!

DEWEY

Well what are we supposed to do about it?

LOUIE

I don't know... Find a cure for old-age-... grump-a-... itus?

HUEY

Uh huh. So just cook up a magic chill pill?

Louie's eyes light up.

LOUIE

That's it!

Huey, nervous, flashes a big fake smile.

HUEY

I mean, yeah! Let's cook up a magic chill pill!

Louie quickly pages through the clipboard.

LOUIE

No, no, no.

Louie walks over to a shelf full of various vials with labels such as "sleep sand", "fairy dust" and "slime mucus".

LOUIE (CONT'D)

We have a magic chill pill.

His hand hovers past a few vials, until he grabs one filled with water.

LOUIE (CONT'D)

This!

HUEY

Something to sooth his throat?

Louie draws on the clipboard, then turns it to show Huey and Dewey. The words "Fountain of Youth" are circled with arrows pointing at it.

LOUIE

Water from the Fountain of Youth!

HUEY

That wouldn't just chill him out...

DEWEY

It'd give us the super cool "too eager" Scrooge we need!

HUEY

But wh-?

Louie and Dewey turn to Huey and raise an eyebrow.

HUEY (CONT'D)

-at's gonna stop us?

Dewey, with a sly grin, takes the clipboard and makes a giant checkmark next to "Fountain of Youth".

DEWEY

SUPER check.

CUT TO:

INT. MCDUCK MANSION - SCROOGE'S OFFICE - DAY

Scrooge sits at his desk looking over paperwork as the boys enter his office.

HUEY

H-hey Uncle Scrooge?

Scrooge looks up at them, cross.

SCROOGE

What?

DEWEY

We're really sorry about earlier.

LOUTE

We were completely outta line.

Scrooge looks at them skeptically.

SCROOGE

Go on.

DEWEY

We really took your scolding to heart.

LOUIE

And we thought you might need...

Louie elbows Huey who nervously pulls out a glass of water.

LOUIE (CONT'D)

Some water to sooth your throat.

Huey shakily hands the glass to Scrooge.

Scrooge studies the glass of water.

SCROOGE

Well... that's very nice.

Scrooge drinks the entire glass. Louie and Dewey eagerly watch, their eyes full of anticipation as Huey fidgets.

SCROOGE (CONT'D)

Ahhh. That hit the spot.

The boys continue to stare at Scrooge.

Scrooge looks behind him for what has caught their gaze.

SCROOGE (CONT'D)

Alright, now off with ya. I need that inventory done by today.

Scrooge shoos the boys off.

CUT TO:

INT. MCDUCK MANSION - HALLWAY - CONTINUOUS

Huey closes the door to Scrooge's office.

Louie throws his arms up in anger.

DEWEY

What the heck happened?!

HUEY

Maybe the fountain doesn't work?

Louie crosses his arms annoyed.

LOUIE

Or maybe he's so old it didn't make a dent.

A BELLOWING SCREAM comes from Scrooge's office.

The boys jump back startled.

Huey walks up and knocks on the door.

HUEY

Everything okay in there?... Uncle Scrooge?

YOUNG SCROOGE (O.S.)

Uncle?

The door slams open revealing YOUNG SCROOGE, a 13 year old version of himself, with Scrooge's now baggy adult clothes.

YOUNG SCROOGE (CONT'D)

They'll pluck me tail feathers before I become some geezer uncle!

END OF ACT 1

ACT 2

INT. MCDUCK MANSION - HALLWAY - DAY

The boys stare in shock as Young Scrooge messes with his clothes.

LOUIE DEWEY

It worked!

Whoa!

YOUNG SCROOGE

Are you the jokers who put me in these? And where the blazes am I?

HUEY

You're...-

Louie jumps in front of Huey.

LOUIE

In America! We're your cousins!
Uh... Secondly removed.

Young Scrooge studies the boys.

YOUNG SCROOGE

Well you're definitely removed. Anyway, can I bother you for some clothes? These smell like...

Young Scrooge takes a big whiff of himself, then shudders.

YOUNG SCROOGE (CONT'D)

Sea salt and ice cream?

Dewey puts his arm around Young Scrooge.

DEWEY

Right this way.

CUT TO:

INT. MCDUCK MANSION - NEPHEW'S BEDROOM - DAY

Dewey shuts him and Young Scrooge inside the closet.

Huey scratches his head as he paces around the room.

HUEY

This isn't good.

LOUIE

Isn't good? It's great! He doesn't just have his young body, he has his young mind too!

HUEY

But he doesn't remember anything.

LOUIE

Like how mad he was at us?

Huey raises a finger to interject, but stops.

HUEY

You know what? I'm cool.

LOUIE

Good.

Dewey bursts out of the closet and gestures behind him.

DEWEY

Introducing... Scrooge McDuck!

Young Scrooge walks out sporting a red velvet bomber jacket with black accents.

LOUIE HUEY

Wow!

Looking good!

YOUNG SCROOGE

Something still feels off...

Young Scrooge spots a baseball bat against the wall. He picks it up and twirls it like a cane.

YOUNG SCROOGE (CONT'D)

Much better, thank you Dewey. Now I didn't quite catch your names.

HUEY

Huey. I like the red.

YOUNG SCROOGE

Couldn't let you be the only one rocking it.

Young Scrooge high fives Huey, who gives a delightful grin.

LOUIE

Louie Duck, owner of Louie Inc.

YOUNG SCROOGE

Ah men of business.

DEWEY

And adventure.

YOUNG SCROOGE

Birds of feather! I once liberated 10 riverboats full of gold from the nefarious Blackheart Beagle and his kin.

LOUIE

The Beagle Boys?

YOUNG SCROOGE

Aye! You've heard of my exploits?

LOUIE

Kinda. We have our own Beagle Boys to deal with.

DEWEY

Care to join us on an adventure of own?

YOUNG SCROOGE

I thought you'd never ask.

CUT TO:

EXT. BEAGLE BOYS SCRAPYARD - DAY

MA BEAGLE lays on a lawn chair outside her trailer, tanning mirror in hand.

Various BEAGLE BOYS patrol the yard or sift gold coins.

BURGER BEAGLE approaches Ma Beagle with a serving tray carrying a slice of cake and the Holy Grail filled with a purple liquid.

He sets it down on the table next to Ma Beagle.

Ma Beagle pick ups the Holy Grail--

--takes a sip--

-- and spit takes right into Burger's face.

MA BEAGLE

I asked for water! This is wine you buffoon!

Burger gives a sad GROWL and trudges off.

Ma Beagle carelessly tosses the Holy Grail aside and picks up her cake.

BY THE ENTRANCE, Huey, Dewey, Louie, and Young Scrooge survey the yard from atop a scrap mound.

LOUIE

Alright here's the plan. Huey will use the magnet crane to draw their attention. Meanwhile Scrooge-

Louie looks over to find Young Scrooge missing.

LOUIE (CONT'D)

Wh-! Where did-?

HUEY

Uh Louie.

Huey points to Young Scrooge riding down a scrap mound inside one of the junked car.

YOUNG SCROOGE

Woohoo!

DEWEY

What is he-?!

LOUIE

Ugh okay, go! Go!

Young Scrooge's car barrels down the mound-

- --crashes through Beagle Boys--
- --until BOUNCER BEAGLE stops it with his bare hands--
- --which flings Young Scrooge out of the car--
- --tackling Bouncer to the ground.

BACK BY THE TRAILER, Ma Beagle jumps up from her chair.

MA BEAGLE

What in the world is going on?!

Louie casually approaches Ma Beagle.

LOUIE

Wow that tan is *really* helping your complexion.

Ma Beagle grabs her purse and crowbar.

MA BEAGLE

I thought I smelled something fowl.

Ma Beagle takes a swing at Louie with her crowbar.

LOUIE

Ah!

MA BEAGLE

Get him!

Ma Beagle chases Louie past the pile of coins deep into the scrapyard.

LOUTE

Do we really need violence? That pun was painful enough.

BIGTIME BEAGLE stops sifting through coins and runs after Ma Beagle, motioning for the others to join him.

BIGTIME

Come on, Ma needs help!

Bigtime and the other Beagle Boys give chase, until suddenly a car is dropped in front of them.

BIGTIME (CONT'D)

What the-?!

Huey sits inside the nearby crane as it lifts another car.

HUEY

Sorry, but you're looking at the Funso's Fun Zone's crane master!

More cars are dropped around Bigtime and his gang, until they are boxed in.

BACK BY THE ENTRANCE, Young Scrooge squares up with Bouncer.

Bouncer throws a punch--

- --Young Scrooge swings his bat--
- --which strikes Bouncer's fist--
- --it hooks outward and hits Burger.

Young Scrooge slides under Bouncer's legs--

- --hooks his ankles with the bat--
- -- and trips Bouncer, who crashes into the ground.

YOUNG SCROOGE

The bigger they are.

DEEP IN THE SCRAPYARD, Ma Beagle traps Louie at a dead end.

MA BEAGLE

End of the line!

FROM ATOP THE CRANE, Huey see's Dewey corned and lowers the giant magnet over to Young Scrooge.

HUEY

(shouting down)

Scrooge hop on!

Young Scrooge hops on the magnet.

Huey swings the magnet full force, sending Young Scrooge flying through the air.

DEEP IN THE SCRAPYARD, Ma Beagle stands over Louie, crowbar raised.

MA BEAGLE

Nighty night.

Young Scrooge soars towards Ma Beagle and cracks his bat across her head, knocking her out cold.

Louie stands there, shocked.

LOUIE

Oh my god!

Huey slides down the crane tether.

YOUNG SCROOGE

That was one heck of a throw.

HUEY

I just calculated the precise swing and momentum. It was your great form that pulled it off!

Young Scrooge and Huey high five.

LOUTE

Guys! Is she okay?

Louie gestures to a Ma Beagle, slumped on the ground.

MA BEAGLE

(dazed mumbling)

Now boys, never trust a stranger. Unless they're rich.

YOUNG SCROOGE

Aye she's fine.

Dewey hops over to them from atop a scrap mound.

DEWEY

That was wild!

LOUTE

Where were you?

DEWEY

Getting some footage for the gram. Check it!

Dewey replays footage of Young Scrooge fighting.

LOUIE

Where am I?

DEWEY

I kinda had to edit out the boring parts.

Dewey pulls out the Holy Grail.

DEWEY (CONT'D)

But I did snag the grail. Now lets get going, I wanna update all my new followers.

YOUNG SCROOGE

And leave all that great loot behind? Not a chance!

Young Scrooge runs off and the boys chase him.

BACK BY THE TRAILER, Young Scrooge grabs coins by the fistful as the boys watch.

LOUIE

Hot dog!

Louie runs over to join Young Scrooge.

DEWEY

I don't know... stealing from thieves isn't really our thing.

SCROOGE

Well leaving money lying around isn't really my thing.

HUEY

Maybe you just need to "be cool".

Huey elbows Dewey as he walks off on his own.

DEWEY

Hey I'm cool.

Dewey walks up to the pile of coins and scoops some up with the Holy Grail. He smiles, but it quickly fades to disinterest.

LOUIE

Oh! Maybe we can use some of their dumb shirts for sacks.

A shadow is cast over the pile of coins and suddenly the coins shoot up into the air.

Scrooge and Louie look up to see the crane magnet suspended above them, the coins stuck to it.

HUEY

Figured we could use this to clean house.

Young Scrooge LAUGHS.

DEWEY

Haha. Now if you're done lets go...

CUT TO:

INT. FUNSO'S FUN ZONE - DAY

Huey, Dewey, Louie and Young Scrooge sit around a table with the giant magnet of coins propped up next to them.

DEWEY

Celebrate!!!

A FEMALE EMPLOYEE brings 25 different pizzas to the table.

LOUIE

Thank you kind miss.

Louie plucks a gold coin from the magnet and tosses it to the female employee as she leaves.

YOUNG SCROOGE

This is what you call an adventure?

LOUIE

Adventure? The adventure is over.

Louie stacks a slice of every pizza on top of each other, then takes a bite.

DEWEY

We came out the victors and now we enjoy the spoils.

A MALE EMPLOYEE brings over a wheelbarrow of sticky hand toys.

MALE EMPLOYEE

Your sticky hands sir.

DEWEY

Thank you.

As the male employee walks away, Dewey grabs a sticky hand and launches it at male employee's back.

The male employee looks around confused, but doesn't notice the hand stuck to his back.

DEWEY (CONT'D)

Classic.

Dewey slings a hand at a bottle of soda aross the room and pulls it to him.

YOUNG SCROOGE

But this is only the start! We can do so much more-

Young Scrooge is hit in the face with a sticky hand.

DEWEY

Ha! Perfect.

Young Scrooge wipes the hand off his face.

YOUNG SCROOGE

Come on. I know a way we could easily double this.

LOUIE

(mouth full)

Double?

Louie forces himself to swallow the pizza and waves the Junior Woodchuck Guidebook in the air.

LOUIE (CONT'D)

Me and Huey are in!

DEWEY

Meh.

HUEY

What's wrong? Not cool enough for you?

DEWEY

It's been a long day man. I just wanna relax.

Huey and Louie lean over the table around Young Scrooge, a look of eagerness on their faces.

HUEY

Well I'm all in.

LOUIE

I'm all in too! So what's the plan?

MATCH CUT TO:

INT. FURNISHED BASEMENT

Huey and Louie now lean over a poker table around Young Scrooge. Louie's eagerness has turned to concern.

Young Scrooge pushes a pile of poker chips into the pot.

YOUNG SCROOGE

All in.

END OF ACT 2

ACT 3

INT. FURNISHED BASEMENT

Huey, Louie and Young Scrooge sit at a poker table.

At the table is also a MOB BOSS, a PIRATE, and a YAKUZA BOSS.

PIRATE

Yee be confident for a small child.

LOUTE

Too confident. That's all our money!

YOUNG SCROOGE

Relax, I'm not losing to these jokers.

Mafia Boss looks at his hand as Yakuza Boss cracks a smile.

MOB BOSS

I fold.

YAKUZA BOSS

Hmmm. All in.

Young Scrooge reveals his hand.

YOUNG SCROOGE

Read em and weep.

The pirate pulls out a sword and stabs the table in a rage.

PIRATE

BLASTED BILGE RAT!

Louie grips his chest.

LOUIE

Oh my God you did it! I was about to have a heart attack.

Young Scrooge leans in to collect the chips.

YOUNG SCROOGE

Better luck next time broke beard.

YAKUZA BOSS

Not so fast.

Yakuza Boss reveals her hand which ties Young Scrooge's.

YOUNG SCROOGE

As I breath.

HUEY

But that's almost mathematically impossible.

YAKUZA BOSS

Care to make a new wager?

LOUIE

YOUNG SCROOGE/HUEY

No way.

We're in!

LOUIE (CONT'D)

What?!

CUT TO:

INT. FUNSO'S FUN ZONE - NIGHT

The walls, machines and guests of Funso's are covered in sticky hand.

Dewey sits next to his near emptied wheelbarrow

He pulls out a sticky hand and shoots it straight up at the ceiling, but it falls smack dab on his face.

Dewey lets out a SIGH and checks his phone.

Dewey see's a new report that shows his video from the scrapyard. He unmutes it.

REPORTER (V.O.)

Authorities are still searching for the man in this viral video who they believe made off with hundreds of gold coins from Duckberg Bank.

DEWEY

Oh boy.

CUT TO:

EXT. ABANDONED CONSTRUCTION SITE - NIGHT.

A crowd of rowdy TEENAGERS with glow sticks fill the area.

In the center of the crowd stands Huey, Louie, Young Scrooge and Yakuza Boss. Next to them are two bright hot rods.

YAKUZA BOSS

Winner takes all in a no holds bar street race.

LOUIE

No, no, absolutely not!

YOUNG SCROOGE

The green one doesn't speak for us. I never back down from a challenge.

Louie gives Huey the Junior Woodchucks Guidebook.

LOUIE

Huey forget about the bet and talk some sense into him!

HUEY

I'm not just doing this for the bet. With my mind and Scrooge's dexterity, I think we can win.

LOUIE

No you cant!

HUEY

You can never trust my judgment can you?

Huey pushes past Louie and approaches Yakuza Boss.

HUEY (CONT'D)

I hope you haven't had your daily recommended calories, because you're about to eat our dust.

Huey and Yakuza Boss shake hands.

Young Scrooge, Huey and Yakuza boss hop into the cars.

MUSIC CUE: "Tokyo Drift" by Teriyaki Boyz

The STARTER takes his place in front of the cars.

STARTER

Racers are you ready?

Young Scrooge and Yakuza Boss REV their engines.

Louie's phone RINGS and he answers.

LOUIE

Hello?

DEWEY (V.O.)

Louie! Where's Scrooge?

LOUIE

Huey and him are about to risk their lives racing the Yakuza!

STARTER

Get set!

DEWEY (V.O.)

You gotta stop them!

LOUIE

I tried telling them this is dumb and reckless! What else is there to say?

STARTER

Go!

The starter shoots a flare into the air.

The cars take off into the street, banking left out of sight.

Seconds later, 3 cop cars chase after them, sirens BLARING.

LOUIE

That's not good.

END MUSIC CUE

CUT TO:

EXT. STREETS OF DUCKBURG - NIGHT

The two cars barrel down the street with Yakuza Boss in the lead

The traffic light in front of them turns red as two MOVERS cross the street with a pane of glass.

The cars don't slow down and the movers brace for impact.

The cars speed by either side of the movers.

One of the movers goes to wipe the sweat off his brow, causing the other to lose their grip and drop the glass pane.

INT. SCROOGE CAR - CONTINUOUS

Young Scrooge sits at the wheel as Huey rides shotgun.

YOUNG SCROOGE

Alright Huey, what's the plan?

HUEY

Get off the road and use that ally to our left!

EXT. STREETS OF DUCKBURG - CONTINUOUS

Young Scrooge's car breaks off from chasing the Yakuza Boss' and slips perfectly through a narrow alley.

INT. YAKUZA CAR - CONTINUOUS

Yakuza Boss checks her rearview mirror to find an empty road.

YAKUZA BOSS

Amateurs.

Suddenly Young Scrooge's car shoots out of the alley and slowly passes on her left.

INT. SCROOGE CAR - CONTINUOUS

HUEY

Drift the next turn, 33 degrees...

EXT. STREETS OF DUCKBURG - CONTINUOUS

HUEY (O.S.)

Now!

Young Scrooge's car drifts left around the corner, which cuts off the Yakuza Boss' car and forces it to come to a stop.

INT. SCROOGE CAR - CONTINUOUS

Young Scrooge and Huey high five!

YOUNG SCROOGE

Great call!

INT. YAKUZA CAR - CONTINUOUS

Yakuza Boss slams her steering wheel in frustration.

YAKUZA BOSS

Oh no you don't.

Yakuza Boss flips open a panel revealing a button that reads "NOS". She slams the button.

INT. SCROOGE CAR - CONTINUOUS

Huey checks the rearview mirror to find an empty street.

HUEY

Still no sign of her.

YOUNG SCROOGE

Looks like she's down for the-

The car shakes violently.

HUEY

YOUNG SCROOGE (CONT'D)

Whoa! What the devil?

EXT. STREETS OF DUCKBURG - CONTINUOUS

The Yakuza Boss' car, now glowing, grinds against the driver's side of Young Scrooge's car as they drive onto an overhead highway.

YOUNG SCROOGE (O.S.)

How is she doing that?

INT. SCROOGE CAR - CONTINUOUS

Young Scrooge looks around the cockpit, pulls out his bat, and rolls down the window.

YOUNG SCROOGE

Grab the wheel!

HUEY

Wait I'm not-!

Young Scrooge hang out the driver window.

Huey frantically hops over to the drivers seat and grabs the steering wheel as the Junior Woodchuck Guidebook falls open in the shotgun seat.

EXT. STREETS OF DUCKBURG - HIGHWAY - CONTINUOUS

Young Scrooge bashes the Yakuza Boss' car with his bat.

Red and blue lights begin to flash in the distance as cop cars form a blockade farther down the highway.

HUEY (O.S.)

Scrooge! Up ahead!

YOUNG SCROOGE

Don't worry about them! Just keep driving.

INT. SCROOGE CAR - CONTINUOUS

Huey's phone RINGS.

HUEY

Phone, answer!

LOUIE (V.O.)

Huey! Can you hear me?!

HUEY

Louie?

LOUIE (V.O.)

I'm sorry we didn't listen to you earlier. You and Scrooge were right! We were being dumb and reckless.

EXT. STREETS OF DUCKBURG - HIGHWAY - CONTINUOUS

Young Scrooge continues to wail on the Yakuza Boss' car as they zoom down the overpass.

YOUNG SCROOGE

Listen up! Right before we get to the blockade, you'll need to us the emergency brake and cut the wheel. That'll send us rolling overtop the blockade. Its our only chance

INT. SCROOGE CAR - CONTINUOUS

Dewey stares intently at the police cars ahead.

HUEY

Okay. Okay.

YOUNG SCROOGE (O.S.)

It's gonna need perfect timing, but you can do this. I know you can.

HUEY

Yeah. Yeah I can do this!

Huey floors the gas and grabs the emergency brake.

LOUIE (V.O.)

We know you can do it, but that doesn't mean you should.

DEWEY (V.O.)

You have to trust us! When I say so, grab Scrooge and jump out of the car over the guardrail.

HUEY

But Scrooge needs me. I promised I would-

DEWEY (V.O.)

Scrooge needs you to do the right thing. Like you always do.

HUEY

But...

Huey looks over to the Junior Woodchuck Guidebook. On the first page it says "Rule #1 Do Right By Others".

DEWEY (V.O.)

Huey?!

Huey stares dead ahead at the blockade.

YOUNG SCROOGE (O.S.)

Get ready!

Huey looks to Young Scrooge who gives him a nod.

DEWEY (V.O.)

Huey you gotta jump now!!!

Huey grabs Young Scrooge by the jacket.

EXT. STREETS OF DUCKBURG - HIGHWAY - CONTINUOUS

Huey leaps from the shotgun door and over the guardrail, pulling Young Scrooge along with him.

HUEY

YOUNG SCROOGE

Ahhh!!!

Leaping lochs!

As Huey and Young Scrooge fall from the overpass, two braided sticky hand ropes fly out towards them.

DEWEY (O.S.)

Grab on!

Huey and Young Scrooge each grab a rope and swing across the skyline.

The ropes retract like a bungee chord and pull them towards a rooftop where Dewey and Louie hold the other ends.

BACK ON THE HIGHWAY, the Yakuza Boss' makes a sharp turn flipping it on its side. The car rolls itself until it stops right in front of the blockade, upside down.

An OFFICER approaches the driver door as the window rolls up, revealing Yakuza Boss upside down and looking nauseous.

OFFICER

Excuse me mam, but we'd like to ask you about some stolen money we found at your finish line.

Yakuza Boss throws up on the officer's shoes.

OFFICER (CONT'D)

Oh god!

The officer grabs his radio.

OFFICER (CONT'D)

We have a 10-55 here, over.

CUT TO:

EXT. DUCKBURG SKYLINE - NIGHT.

Louie and Dewey pull Huey and Young Scrooge up onto the roof.

HUEY

Sorry guys... guess I kinda went a bit far.

LOUIE

Its our fault we shouldn't have pushed your button like that. We'll try to listen more.

DEWEY

And next adventure is all your choice.

The boys embrace for a group hug.

YOUNG SCROOGE

Well glad you learned yourself a lesson.

LOUTE

No thanks to your insanity.

HUEY

How are we going to get the old Scrooge back?

YOUNG SCROOGE

Don't worry about that, the fountain's effects should wear off by tomorrow.

The boys look at Young Scrooge in shock.

DEWEY

Wait. Its been you the whole time?

YOUNG SCROOGE

Well entirely. My memory jogged sometime at Funso's.

LOUIE

You did all of this, just to teach us a lesson?!

DEWEY

You almost got Huey killed!

YOUNG SCROOGE

Nonsense.

Young Scrooge walks over to Huey and puts his arm around him.

YOUNG SCROOGE (CONT'D)

You had it all under control lad.

Young Scrooge gives Huey a wink and a warm grin.

Young Scrooge walks to the side of the roof and kicks a ladder which drops down the side of the building.

YOUNG SCROOGE (CONT'D)

Now come along.

The boys look to each other wearily, then make their way down the ladder.

DEWEY

(whisper)

Never let me call Scrooge old again.

HUEY

(whisper)
I tried to stop you the first time!

Young Scrooge follows the boys down the ladder

YOUNG SCROOGE

And once we get back I expect a full inventory of the archives.

HUEY/DEWEY/LOUIE

Aww man!
